### 2013 Château Saint-Roch Côtes du Roussillon Chimères Rouge (\$15.89)

"60% Grenache, 30% Syrah and 10% Carignan. Savory notes of kirsch and assorted darker berry fruits, pepper, truffle and damp earth. Full-bodied, thrillingly textured and with incredible purity of fruit, this knockout effort stays lively and elegant, with fine tannin, terrific length and no hard edges. It will knock your socks off. Ridiculously under-priced given its quality. Drink now through 2020." –*Wine Advocate*, 93 points.

### 2015 Château Saint-Roch Vieilles Vignes Côtes du Roussillon Blanc (\$13.99)

"A blend of mostly Grenache Blanc, with 20% Roussanne, the 2015 Côtes du Roussillon Vieilles Vignes has exotic, vibrant notes of lime, apple peel and mint to go with a racy, saliva-inducing style on the palate. Drink this clean, crisp white on release through 2017." –*Wine Advocate*, 91 points.

**2013 Buty Red Blend Conner Lee Vineyard**  
**\$48.99/\$41.99/\$37.79**

“Supple, velvety and generous, with red plum, cherry and dusky spice flavors coursing easily past the fine tannins into a long and expressive finish. Shows presence and depth. 61% Merlot and 39% Cabernet Franc. Drink now through 2022. 310 cases made.”

**2009 Page Cellars Preface E & E Shaw Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Red Mountain** **\$39.99/\$30.79/\$27.71**

“Preface is Page Cellars flagship wine. This is pure Red Mountain. Plenty of depth, power and complexity, with big-beautiful blackberry flavors. Loaded with aromatic spices, and its got enormously complex layer after layer. The 2009 Page Cellars Preface has a gorgeous balance of age worth tannins. Seductive, soft, elegant finish.”

**2013 Domaine de la Bastide Blanche Bandol Rouge**  
**\$32.99/\$26.19/\$23.57**

“Red Solid, with tobacco and Turkish coffee notes leading the way to a core of steeped plum and blackberry purée flavors. Leather and juniper details drive the finish. 500 cases imported. Best from 2018 through 2025.” –*Wine Spectator*, 91 points. **New item.**

**2014 Talbott Kali Hart Estate Grown Pinot Noir Monterey**  
**\$30.99/\$22.99/\$20.69**

“This well-priced bottling offers Italian herbs on the nose, from oregano to marjoram, alongside tart red cherries, dried tobacco, cola and a touch of smoke. Graphite minerality frames the sip, which shows red cherries cooked with thyme and bay leaf, as well as rustic sagebrush. It’s complex, tense and lingering.”

**2010 Beresan The Buzz Red Yellow Jacket Vineyard Red Walla Walla Valley** **\$22.99/\$19.59/\$17.63**

“Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon are the principal components, with smaller amounts of Cab Franc and Merlot, all from one of the estate vineyards located in the Rocks (Walla Walla’s soon-to-be newest sub-AVA). Strongly tannic, its core of cassis fruit is anchored in potent flavors of iron, earth and licorice. Editors’ Choice.”

**2014 Barnard Griffin Syrah Columbia Valley**  
**\$24.99/\$14.39/\$12.95**

“Lush and juicy, with red and black fruit flavors, offering raspberry and plum notes on a polished frame that shows some transparency. Drink now through 2020.” –*Wine Spectator*, 89 points. **New vintage.**

**2015 Bodega Santa Julia Reserva Malbec Uco Valley Mendoza Argentina** **\$15.99/\$12.19/\$10.97**

“A little Beaujolais-like in style, this is fragrant, vibrant and easy to drink. A little unusual, rustic and a touch stinky, but it is filled with fresh fruits and a friendly texture that welcomes you right from the first sip. A vin de soif style, ready now. Drink now through 2015.”

**2015 Hahn GSM Central Coast California** **\$16.99/\$11.19/\$10.07**

“60% Grenache, 37% Syrah and 3% Mourvèdre. Each of the three grape types blended into this wine adds distinctive aromas and flavors. Grenache contributes raspberry, strawberry and cherry flavors, while Syrah lends color, tannins and hints of blueberry and black pepper. The Mourvèdre adds richness to the mid-palate and lengthens the dry finish.” –Winery notes. **New vintage.**

## White Wines

**2014 DeLille Cellars ‘Chaleur Estate’ Blanc Columbia Valley**  
**\$39.99/\$35.99/\$32.39**

“Alluring aromas of stone fruits, pineapple, honey, smoked meat and lees, with complicating notes of pine needles and forest floor. Fat, layered and sweet, boasting terrific fruit concentration and a hint of dried fig from the Semillon. Less than two grams per liter residual sugar. A wonderfully rich, fine-grained white wine with sexy leesy complexity.” – *Antonio Galloni*, 93 points

**2014 Duckhorn Vineyards Napa Valley Chardonnay**  
**\$40.99/\$26.99/\$24.29**

“From its aromas of Bosc pear, lemon cream, vanilla and to its silky entry and bright minerality, this is a vibrant and complex Chardonnay. On the palate, it strikes a beautiful balance between richness and elegance, with a lush texture and abundant flavors of white peach and Mandarin orange framed by lively acidity and hints of baked apple and elderflower.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**



**2015 William Fevre Champs Royaux Chablis Burgundy**  
**\$32.99/\$22.39/\$20.15**

“Fresh bouquet with notes of citrus and white fleshed fruit, with a very slightly oaky finish. Fresh and supple, the wine is marked by mineral notes that are typical of the appellation.”

**2015 Long Shadows Poet’s Leap Riesling Columbia Valley**

“The terrific 2015 Riesling Poet’s Leap has 1.2% residual sugar, which is barely noticeable. Juicy, vibrant notes of green apple, citrus and lychee all emerge from this medium-bodied, fresh, clean, deliciously refreshing white that will be incredibly versatile on the dinner table. It will also age gracefully now through 2026.”

**2015 Château Saint-Roch Vieilles Vignes Côtes du Roussillon**

“A blend of mostly Grenache Blanc, with 20% Roussanne, the 2015 Côtes du Roussillon Vieilles Vignes has exotic, vibrant notes of lime, apple peel and mint to go with a racy, saliva-inducing style on the palate. Drink this clean, crisp white on release through 2017.”

**2014 Cave de Saumur ‘Saumur Blanc’ Les Pouches Loire Valley**  
**\$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45**

100% Chenin Blanc. There’s a lovely, mature, creamy mouthfeel to this, with fig, quince, persimmon and glazed pear flavors that glide through the lush, medium-weight finish. Ripe and showy, but still dry and racy in the end. **Delicious. New vintage.**

**Henriot Brut Rosé Champagne NV** **\$88.99/\$59.49/\$53.54**

“A beautiful range of aromatic spices accents the white raspberry, pastry and pink grapefruit notes in this harmonious Rosé. There’s tension to the knit of vibrant acidity and chalky texture, driving this to a lasting, mineral finish. Drink now through 2020.”

**Henriot Brut Champagne Souverain NV** **\$64.99/\$34.99/\$31.49**

“A firm Champagne, with a lively bead and a mineral undertow, this offers flavors of fresh-cut apple, lemon pith, spring blossom and smoke. Moderate finish. Drink now.” –*Wine Spectator*, 90 points
