2013 Jack Winery Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley (\$89.99) (regularly \$100.00)

From cleats to corks: Seattle Mariner catcher, Chris Iannetta, brings his own wine to the Northwest in Jack Winery, formed in 2012 along with former teammate Vernon Wells. "The Cabernet Sauvignon, made from grapes grown on Diamond Mountain and Howell Mountain, brings our bold, rich, mountain-style Cabernet with briary fruit characteristics, boasting undertones of herbs, tobacco and mocha with the strong backing of tannin structure." -Winery notes. **Limited.**

2014 Jack Winery Sauvignon Blanc Napa Valley (\$44.99) (regularly \$50.00)

"Our single vineyard Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc is a remarkable culmination of pineapple and spicy pear, with floral notes of honeysuckle and orange blossom. Your palate is greeted with a creamy, mouthwatering beginning with a clean and crisp finish. 88% Sauvignon Blanc, 12% Sauvignon Musque." -Winery notes. **Limited.**

Red Wines

2013 Jack Winery Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley \$99.99/\$89.99/\$80.99

From cleats to corks: Seattle Mariner catcher, Chris Iannetta, brings his own wine to the Northwest in Jack Winery, formed in 2012 along with former teammate Vernon Wells. “The Cabernet Sauvignon, made from grapes grown on Diamond Mountain and Howell Mountain, brings our bold, rich, mountain-style Cabernet with briary fruit characteristics, boasting undertones of herbs, tobacco and mocha with the strong backing of tannin structure.”

2012 Andrew Will Bordeaux Red Blend Ciel du Cheval Yakima Valley \$65.99/\$56.69/\$51.02

“Another killer wine from Chris, 50% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon and 20% Cabernet Franc. It exhibits classic minerality and dried herbs to go with complex leather, lavender, currants and sweet black cherry fruit. This gives way to a full-bodied, big-boned and layered 2012 that has no shortage of tannin and a great mid-palate. Drink 2017-2032.” -*Wine Advocate*, 95 points. **New vintage.**

2012 Heritage Cabernet Sauvignon Rutherford Napa Valley \$52.99/\$42.99/\$38.69

“Bernard Portet, who helped found Clos du Val in 1972 and ran it for 38 years, started Heritage as a retirement project. His 2012 has the kind of structure and austerity that marked some of the classic vintages of Clos du Val. It starts out with sour cherry tartness, gains richness in the middle and then lasts on sleek, dry tannins. The wine leaves a smoky, peppery, earthy impression.”

2014 Napa Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley \$26.99/\$23.79/\$21.41

“Showcases elegant and concentrated aromas of ripe blackberry, black cherry and cassis with blueberry notes. A lush core of ripe dark fruit, boysenberry, chocolate nibs, slight tobacco, spicy black pepper, star anise and hints of toffee and mocha linger through the finish. This wine is full-bodied with balanced acidity and well-integrated, supple tannins.” —Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2014 Erse Etna Rosso Tenuta di Fessina Sicily \$31.99/\$23.39/\$21.05

“Now the world understands that Etna can produce fresh, energetic reds that are pure, elegant, subtle and vivacious.” - Eric Asimov, NY Times, 1/28/16. “Erse is made from 80% Nerello Mascalese and 20% Nerello Cappuccio grown in the ancient volcanic soils on the hillsides of Mount Etna, the highest active volcano in Europe. The grapes are fermented and aged in stainless steel. An elegant and terroir-driven wine, full-bodied and silky-textured. Immediately enjoyable.” —Winery notes. **New vintage.**

2013 Château Pégaü Cuvée Maclura Rouge Côtes du Rhône \$21.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

“This is the rare Côtes du Rhône that needs cellaring, but it is sourced from a patch of 50-year-old vines. Ground cinnamon, clove, fine leather and just enough cherry fruit mingle to create a compelling, medium-bodied wine framed by fine-grained tannins. 60% Grenache, 25% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre and 5% Cinsault. Drink 2017–2022, possibly beyond. Cellar Selection.”

2013 Mas d'en Compte Black Slate Porrera Priorat Spain \$21.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

“A blend of 60% Grenache and 40% Carignan aged in a combination of concrete tanks. Large wood foudres and smaller French oak barrels. The wine offers loads of licorice and black raspberries and seems to represent the quintessential style of Priorat in its opulence—floral, blueberry and black raspberry fruit, intense minerality and silky, lush tannins. Drink now through 2023.”

2015 St. Hallett Faith Shiraz Barossa Valley South Australia \$20.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

Incredibly good and inexpensive too! Layers of black fruit sneak up on you, and there is just enough pepper to lift but not overwhelm the fruit. The St. Hallett winery was founded in the Barossa nearly 70 years ago. It is a noteworthy producer of wines across the price spectrum, and Faith is at all points happy! **New vintage.**

2014 Tenuta La Favola Red Nero d'Avola Sicily \$16.99/\$13.09/\$11.78

The Nero is natural yeast fermented 100% Nero d'Avola. Eight-day maceration fermented and aged seven months in stainless steel. Medium to light body, bright acidity with good balance of tannins. Notes of pepper, spice and red fruit (tart raspberry/cherry skins). The family-owned winery is certified organic, run on green energy and located on the southern-most point of Sicily. **New item.**

White Wines

2015 Cakebread Cellars Sauvignon Blanc Napa Valley \$41.99/\$29.49/\$26.54

“Bright, super-fresh aromas of sweet citrus, melon, guava and white flowers introduce pure, vibrant flavors of grapefruit, gooseberry, fleshy melon and white peach, with a refreshing minerality invigorating the wine’s long, crisp finish. Arguably one of Cakebread Cellars’ best-ever sauvignon blancs, this Napa Valley classic will age gracefully for the next 3-5 years.” —Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**



2015 Mercer Sauvignon Blanc Princeton Vineyard Horse Heaven Hills \$21.99/\$14.99/\$13.49

“This Sauvignon blanc is bursting with aromas of grapefruit, passion fruit and boxwood. The voluminous aromatics carry through in the mouth with flavors of gooseberry and citrus. Capturing the fruit at its peak ripeness has resulted in a wine with both bold fruit and racy, mouth watering acidity. Clean, crisp, light bodied and refreshing.”

–Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Jean Perrier & Fils Jacquere Blanc Cuvée Gastronomique Savoie \$16.99/\$10.29/\$9.26

“Yellow apple, fennel and lemon zest notes form the core, while lively floral and quinine accents stretch out the finish. Not big, but offers lovely cut and purity. Very refreshing. Smart Buy. Drink now through 2017.” –*Wine Spectator*, 90 points. **New item.**

2015 Château L’Ermitage ‘Tradition’ Blanc Costières de Nîmes \$12.99/\$9.89/\$8.09

Aromas of orange blossom and a stony, flinty quality. The 20% Viognier and 20% Grenache Blanc add a natural richness of peach and ripe nectarine flavors, which are balanced by the fresh grapefruit and citrus characters from the 60% Roussanne, with a touch of mineral complexity. This is bouncy and modern but remains of its place. **New vintage.**

2015 Pajot Damien Barreau Les Cépages Vins De Gascogne \$10.99/\$7.49/\$6.74

A blend of four grape varieties (“Les Quatre Cépages”): 35% Sauvignon Blanc, 35% Colombard, 20% Ugni Blanc and 10% Gros Manseng that combine to make one of the easiest drinking wines. Has aromas of jasmine, ginger, golden raisin, kiwi and grapefruit. The mouthfeel is different, not fruity at all. It has a strong minerality reminiscent of wet gravel. This wine is dry, crisp, and clean.

Certified organic. New vintage.

2015 Mont Gravet Colombard Blanc Côtes de Gascogne \$9.99/\$7.49/\$6.74

An intense and refreshing nose. It displays flavors of citrus fruit and black currant leaf. Good acidity behind the bright green herb and crunchy pippin apple flavors, with notes of citrus zest. Hints of richness emerge on the creamy finish. As a tribute to the terroir from where the wine comes from, it has been named in Montgravet, “Gravet” being the name of an oval-shaped rock commonly found in the area. **New vintage.**

Rosé Wines

2015 Domaine Pélaquié Tavel Rosé \$21.99/\$14.99/\$13.49

Domaine Pélaquié is a family-run estate with a long history; the estate has been passed down father to son for generations, cultivating the same land all the way back to the 16th century! The current son in charge, Luc Pélaquié, has modernized the winery. A deep and vibrant pink color, this Rosé classic is robust, rich, spicy and dry, deftly walking the line of fully ripe fruit and acidity to balance. 70% Grenache and 30% Cinsault. **New item.**

2015 Domaine Petroni Rosé Corse Corsica \$13.99/\$10.69/\$9.62

Rich and intense on the nose, displaying floral and fresh fruit aromas and a touch of minerality. The same complexity is found on the palate, where the wine is long lingering and refreshing. Blend of 45% Sciaccarellu, 40% Grenache and 15% Niellucciu. **New item.**

2015 Domaine Le Clos des Lumières Rosé Côtes du Rhône \$12.99/\$8.39/\$7.55

Very fine nose dominated by strawberry aromas. The palate will again reveal the strawberries, in addition to cherry. The mid-palate shows some spiciness, followed by a pink grapefruit and flint finish. A blend of 40% Cinsault, 30% Grenache, 20% Syrah and 10% Mourvèdre. **New vintage.**
