Does the Fall weather have you looking for a hearty, cozy red to curl up with? Check out these two new arrivals for under \$20!

### 2013 Château La Nerthe Les Cassagnes Rouge Côtes du Rhône Villages (\$19.99)

“On the nose, intense red fruits with some black cherry notes. A beautiful freshness on the palate, with roundness. The finish is long with notes of candied red fruit highlighted by sweet spices. Fresh, silky texture on the finish. 60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Cinsault, 5% Mourvèdre and 5% Carignan.” - Winemaker notes.

### 2014 Kerloo Cellars Majestic Red Wine Columbia Valley (\$18.99)

“A blend of 54% Grenache, 38% Mourvèdre and 8% Syrah, with the fruit coming from some of the state’s top sites. What’s most striking about the wine—other than its exceptional price—is the aromatic purity, with notes of herbs, flowers, raspberry, orange peel and plum. The palate meanwhile puts a premium on texture, with a stretched out finish. It’s a one wine primer on what’s exciting about Rhône-style blends in Washington. Drink up! Editors’ Choice.”

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## Red Wines

### 2010 Château Pédesclaux Pauillac \$64.99/\$54.99/\$49.49

50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot and 5% Cabernet Franc. “Very pretty with currants, chocolate and hints of cappuccino. Full body, with velvety tannins and a long delicious finish. This the best wine in years from here. Better in 2017.” -James Suckling, 93 points. **New item.**

### 2013 Efeste Final-Final Red Blend Columbia Valley \$34.99/\$29.99/\$26.99

“Saturated, dark purple in color, the 2013 Final Final explodes from the glass with intensity highlighted by aromas of dark berries, toasted grains, baker’s chocolate and grilled bread. This is followed by hints of tar and crushed rock. Fresh, big, and bold, the palate is firmly framed yet extends for miles in each dimension as the finish lingers seductively.” -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

### 2012 La Chenade Lalande De Pomerol Denis Durantou \$29.99/\$25.99/\$23.39

Great value, right-bank claret. It is dark, supple and inviting, with plenty of sweet black cherry, plum, licorice, leather and smoke flavors. Ample and layered throughout, the 2012 is an excellent choice for drinking now and over the next ten years. La Chenade is 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon taken from parcels planted on gravel. **New item.**

### 2012 Podere Ruggeri Corsini Armujan Superior Barbera d’Alba Piedmont \$24.99/\$20.59/\$18.53

“This Barbera Armujan comes from 70-year-old vines in the prime Barolo village of Monforte d’Alba. Armujan is our pride and joy. Alongside Barolo Bussia Corsini, this wine is highly appreciated and recognized by international oenology journals. It can be drunk young or be put to age for eight to ten years. Its nose is fresh, with soft scents of ripe plum, sensations that are carried through onto the palate.”  
—Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

### 2015 Syncline Subduction Red Wine Columbia Valley \$23.99/\$20.59/\$18.53

“Long inspired by the wines of the southern Rhône Valley, this is our answer to a Washington version of a Côtes-du-Rhône Villages wine. A blend of classic southern French varieties that are unique and expressive on their own; yet each contributes to create a harmonious whole. 52% Syrah, 21% Mourvèdre. 11% Grenache, 10% Cinsault, 4% Carignan and 2% Counoise. **New vintage.**

### 2013 Château La Nerthe Les Cassagnes Rouge Côtes du Rhône Villages \$29.99/\$19.99/\$17.99

“On the nose, intense red fruits with some black cherry notes. A beautiful freshness on the palate, with roundness. The finish is long with notes of candied red fruit highlighted by sweet spices. Fresh, silky texture on the finish. 60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Cinsault, 5% Mourvèdre and 5% Carignan.”

### 2014 Kerloo Cellars Majestic Red Wine Columbia Valley \$25.99/\$18.99/\$17.09

“A blend of 54% Grenache, 38% Mourvèdre and 8% Syrah, with the fruit coming from some of the state’s top sites. ### 2013 Zisola Rosso Nero d’Avola Sicily \$35.99/\$17.99/\$16.19

“A lovely, medium-bodied red, with a pure beam of ripe cherry and fresh acidity layered with supple tannins and accents of star anise, dried thyme, loamy earth and mocha. Drink now through 2023. #89 Wine Spectator Top 100 of 2015.” -Wine Spectator, 90 points. **New vintage**

### 2014 Joseph Drouhin Laforêt Pinot Noir Bourgogne \$20.99/\$15.89/\$14.30

“We have a good palette of aromas and flavors. My Pinots Noirs come from the Côte Chalonnaise for the elegance and the north of the Côte de Nuits for depth. With this structure, LaForêt is a faithful wine, and we rediscover these traits from year to year.” -Véronique Boss-Drouhin winemaker. **New vintage.**



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**2014 Château Saint-Roch "Chimères" Côtes du Roussillon**  
**\$19.99/\$15.89/\$14.30**

"Mostly Grenache, yet includes 30% Syrah and 10% Mourvèdre. Has terrific purity in its raspberry, violet, licorice and olive-laced aromas and flavors. Ripe, nicely textured and with bright acidity. This wine represents incredible value. Drink now through 2020." —*Wine Advocate*, 90-92 points. —**New vintage.**

**2012 Château Haut Beyzac Cru Bourgeois Haut Médoc**  
**\$21.99/\$13.99/\$12.59**

"Dark ruby color. Bright, fruity, toasty aromas and flavors of black plums, black currants, walnut skin, and cedar with a lightly tannic, bright, dry body and a warming, medium-long finish with well-integrated, firm, fine tannins and moderate oak." - Beverage Testing Institute

**2014 Domaine Petroni Corse Rouge Corsica \$13.99/\$11.19/\$10.07**

Domaine Petroni is an estate on the eastern side of Corsica near Lake Diane. This idyllic location overlooks the Mediterranean with its vineyards composed of sandy and clay soils. The rouge is a blend of 50% Niellucciu, 35% Syrah and 15% Grenache. Grapes are fermented in concrete tanks and aged 12 months in stainless to preserve the fresh fruit driven aspects of the wine. **New item.**

**2015 Bacaro Red Nero d'Avola Sicily \$14.99/\$11.39/\$10.25**

"100% Nero D'Avola. Ruby red, intense, with purplish highlights, transparent. Intense aroma, with red fruit, balsamic and floral hints. Warm, long-lasting, with aftertaste of wood flower." —Winery notes. **New vintage.**

**2015 Luccarelli Negroamaro Rosso Puglia \$13.99/\$10.69/\$9.62**

Plush aromas of sweet dark cherries, plum cake, rich mocha chocolate, baking spices and a pinch of pepper. Concentrated dark fruit rolls into pipe tobacco, chocolate, cedar and spice that lingers. **New vintage.**

**2015 Hayes Valley Cabernet Sauvignon Central Coast**  
**\$12.99/\$9.99/\$8.99**

100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Aromas of cassis, dried cranberry, coffee and cocoa. A hint of dark cherry and tobacco. Fruit flavors are up front, cherry and fresh cranberry. Medium tannins and acidity. The flavors carry through to the finish, along with a little vanilla and cocoa. **New item.**

**2015 Hayes Valley Zinfandel Central Coast California**  
**\$12.99/\$9.99/\$8.99**

On the nose, blackberries and raspberries are in the forefront, with secondary aromas of cinnamon, allspice and vanilla. Fruit flavors dominate, blackberries and cherries. Some solid cool-climate acidity balances nicely with medium tannins. On the finish it is that telltale Zinfandel spicy pepper. 75% Zinfandel, 25% Alicante Bouschet. **New vintage.**

**2014 Domaine Força Rouge Mas de la Garrigue Côtes du Roussillon Villages \$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45**

"Slightly less concentrated [than its big brother] and straightforward, the 2014 Côtes du Roussillon Villages Mas de la Garrigue (60% Grenache, 30% Syrah and 10% Carignan) offers notes of juicy berry fruits, fruit cake and garrigue in a medium-bodied, charming package. It's geared for near term drinking." *Wine Advocate*, 87 points. **New vintage.**

**2015 Château La Vernède Côteaux de Languedoc**  
**\$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45**

For more than 100 years, Château La Vernède has been passed from one generation to the next. Today, Jean-Marc Ribet is leading the Château into the 21st century. Comprised of Grenache, Syrah, Carignan and Mourvèdre, this wine will become one of your favorite "everyday reds". Soft and lush. Bright berries with a touch of spice. **New vintage.**

## White Wines

**2014 Elizabeth Rose Chardonnay Napa Valley \$21.99/\$18.69/\$16.82**

"Welcoming aromas of ripe pear, tropical fruit notes, with honey undertones are sure to please. The unique style, in which this wine is crafted, with no oak treatment, provides stone and tropical fruits on the palate, with a crisp and clean finish. A full and plump body, this Elizabeth Rose Chardonnay will pair nicely with any shellfish, or a seafood pasta dish. 300 cases."

**2015 Vallevó Pecorino Costa dei Trabocchi Abruzzo**  
**\$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59**

"100% Pecorino. It is crisp, dry and minerally. Straw-yellow in color and has an elegantly floral bouquet of acacia and jasmine. Sometimes spiced with a faint hint of licorice. Very well-priced." —Winery notes. **New item.**

**2015 Gradis'ciutta White Ribolla Giulia Collio Friuli Venezia Italy**  
**\$16.99/\$13.09/\$11.78**

100% Ribolla Gialla. Delicate but enticing aromas of citrus and apple follow through to the vibrant, polished palate along with peach, tangerine zest and a mineral note. Crisp acidity gives it a clean, quenching finish. **New vintage.**

**2015 Vallevò White Trebbiano d'Abruzzo \$12.99/\$9.99/\$8.99**

An all around great value for a white wine to keep in your fridge on a very regular basis! This classic Abruzzo white made from the Trebbiano grape is light, dry and refreshing, with a nice range in aroma and flavor complexity.
