2014 Château Bizard Montagne de Raucoule (\$13.99)

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Red Wines

2011 Giuseppe Lonardi Amarone della Valpolicella \$87.99/\$75.99/\$68.39

“Of all the wines of Italia, none is more breath-takingly unique than the wine of Verona called Amarone. His Amarone is remarkably port-like and very concentrated, with powerful, heady aromas of dried fruit potpourri, chocolate, cedar chest, and exotic spice. The production is micro, and it shows in this luxurious, breathtaking wine. That is one reason why this monumental wine will age for 30+ years.” –Small Vineyards

2014 Domaine Tempier Rouge Bandol \$48.99/\$41.99/\$37.29

“Made up of between 70 and 75% Mourvèdre (depending on the year) combined with Grenache, Cinsault and a hint (2%) of old Carignan. This fruity, well balanced wine can be enjoyed after 3 or 4 years, but develops extremely pleasant tertiary aromas (leather, animal and undergrowth) with further ageing. The wine’s balance gives it an ageing potential of 15 years or more.”

2011 Château La Fleur St. Emilion Grand Cru \$46.99/\$39.99/\$35.99

“A big time sleeper of the vintage, La Fleur continues to soar in quality. The 2011 offers consumers a lusty, hedonistic fruit bomb possessing loads of black cherry, black currant, licorice and incense characteristics. This round, generously endowed, medium-bodied wine exhibits silky smooth tannins, good vibrancy and definition, and a long, satisfying finish. Enjoy it over the next decade.”

2015 Brick House Gamay Noir Ribbon Ridge Oregon \$35.99/\$29.89/\$26.90

Brick House gained Biodynamic certification in 2005. The winery has long been known for its exceptional Gamay. Black walnut, smoke, black cherry, fresh herbs and dark earth on the nose. Fairly full body, round with ripe cherry, plum cranberry, caramel, herbs, black pepper and woody notes. **New vintage.**

2011 Watermill Estate Malbec Walla Walla Valley \$33.99/\$29.39/\$26.45

From this small family-owned winery on the Oregon side of the Walla Walla Valley. Aromas of blue fruit, mocha, graphite and anise. The palate is lush and pretty with blueberry, chocolate, and plum jam. The finish shows a bit of vanilla and has plenty of length. **New vintage.**

2014 Walla Walla Vintners Merlot Walla Walla Valley \$37.99/\$27.99/\$25.19

“The attention-getting nose of cedar, oak and violet jumps from the glass and takes you to a sweet espresso beginning, a thick middle of wild huckleberry jam and a finish that dances with flavors of caramel, mocha, leather and fresh black Mission fig.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2014 Salem Wine Co. Gamay Seven Springs Estate Vineyard Willamette Valley \$31.99/\$26.19/\$23.57

“The vines grow in iron-rich volcanic soils. For our stylistic reference point, we aim our compass at Fleurie, the only cru of Beaujolais’ ten crus with a preponderance of volcanic soils. The Salem Wine Co. wines are crafted to be approachable and authentic, consumed in their youth, with very little sulfur. Biodynamic. 300 cases made.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2012 Five Star Cellars Sangiovese Walla Walla Valley \$30.99/\$26.19/\$23.57

“Brooding aromas of pomegranate, strawberry and spice lead to tart cranberry and raspberry flavors that display exceptional balance, detail and length, with high-wire acidity. Editors’ Choice.” –*Sean P. Sullivan*, 91 points. **New vintage.**

2014 Dozon Clos du Saint Ac Loup Chinon \$26.99/\$21.49/\$19.34

Slightly crisp, with bitter cherry and damson plum fruit laced with bay leaf, green olive and savory notes. Shows enough stuffing on the finish for balance, but definitely on the lighter side of the spectrum. **New item.**

2015 For A Song Pinot Noir Willamette Valley \$23.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

Red apple skin, fresh beets, mushrooms and cinnamon exude from the glass. Sweet dried fruit, sandalwood and Christmas cake come through with a luscious mouthfeel and long, silken finish. **New vintage.**



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2014 Château Bizard Montagne de Raucoule \$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

"Aromatic and rich, expresses scents of black fruits –blackberry, sloe, cherry- underscored by notes of liquorice. Retro-olfaction of ripe fruits and spices. Well-structured, fine and coated tannins. A very pleasant wine, cajoling and mellow." –Winemaker notes. **New item. A must buy!**

2015 Bastide de Coupe-Roses Rouge Minervois \$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

"The nose reminds the Carignan from which come this wine, fruity, it is also in mouth where fresh red fruits dominates, associated with a refreshing acidity. A perfect wine for all occasions, aperitifs or meals. A blend of Carignan and Grenache. And a little touch of Syrah!"

2014 Nottola Rosso di Montepulciano Tuscany \$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

Vino Nobile and Rosso are made primarily from the Prugnolo Gentile clone of Sangiovese (80%) and 20% other red grape varieties. The Rosso ages for just six months in Slovenian oak barrels. It is ruby red with an intensely fruity aroma with hints of violet. The palate is subtle and balanced with bright fruit and dusty tannins. **New vintage.**

2014 Ravenswood Zinfandel Lodi \$26.99/\$13.39/\$12.05

"Ravenswood Lodi Zin is bursting with luscious red cherry and plum, with acidity so bright it could light a room. The mouthfeel is seductively soft and perfectly plush. This wine is weighty without aggressive tannins. On the playful finish, expect fantastic fruit flavor."

2013 Domaine Girard Rouge Côtes de Malepère \$16.99/\$11.19/\$10.07

Domaine Girard is a fifth-generation producer. A blend of 40% Cabernet Franc and 60% Merlot that was all hand-harvested, fermented and matured entirely in stainless steel to preserve the pure varietal character. Supple and full-bodied red, with fine tannins and a smooth mouthfeel, this is simply bursting with ripe blue and red fruit flavors that are accented by spicy notes on palate and

2014 Domaine Pierre Guindon Gamay Côteaux d'Ancenis \$10.99/\$8.99/\$8.21

Bright, fresh and unabashedly easy drinking, this delightful Gamay comes from 55-year-old vines in the Loire Valley's Coteaux d'Ancenis. The cool maritime influence delivers elevated acidity which complement notes of fresh raspberries, wild strawberries and red flowers. There is a nice black rock component that adds character towards the finish. **New item.**

White Wines

2014 Domaine Paul Cherrier Sancerre \$22.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

Stéphane Cherrier decided to get back to old-fashioned winemaking in a region where wines were becoming a bit too homogenized, mechanized and over-treated with chemicals. Classic Sancerre aromas of citrus and flint. Lime and passionfruit come through on the palate. Such a fresh finish with racy acidity, mineral and structure. Given the small harvest of 2014 Sancerre this is an amazing value. **New item.**

2015 Pomelo Sauvignon Blanc California \$20.99/\$16.79/\$15.11

"Lemon-lime, ruby grapefruit and green apple flavors are crisp and refreshing, with a note of matcha green tea on the finish. Drink now."

2015 Domaine le Fay d'Homme Muscadet -Sèvre et Maine sur lie \$16.99/\$13.09/\$11.78

The fifth generation in his family of winemakers. The acidity is present but not aggressive, with expression of white fruits, citrus and blossoms. The wine is immediately very well balanced and enjoyable right after bottling. Perfect with fish when drank young, you will enjoy the evolution of its aromas better with white meat after 10 years in your cellar. A true experience and new discovery of the aged Muscadet.

2015 Collefriso Pecorino "Terre di Chieti" D'Abruzzo Italy \$16.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

"An unusual and stylish dry white wine from the Pecorino grape variety in the D'Abruzzo region of Italy. Orange peel and floral on the nose. Rich dry flavors of oranges and bananas in the mouth. minerally and salty at the finish. From the same region as the famous pecorino cheese. –*Wine Advocate*, 88 points. **New item.**

2016 Château Bizard Blanc d'Amour Grignan Les Adhémar \$15.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

"Aromatic, complex, fruity. Exhales fragrances of grapefruit, white peach, lychee and acacia flower. Beautiful balance on the palate, ample and suave, with a fresh finish. A blend of Viognier, Grenache Blanc, Marsanne and Roussanne." –Winemaker notes. **New item Excellent!**

2015 Barnard Griffin Chardonnay Columbia Valley \$19.99/\$10.59/\$9.53

"Our 2015 Chardonnay opens with vibrant pear, peach and pineapple flavors highlighted by lemon zest and citrus notes. Very crisp and refreshing! A touch of lime and oak spice chimes in on the long finish. A great accompaniment to a broad range of food choices."
